UPCOMING MISSION TRIPS TO HAITI FOR SNMA MEMBERS

Through the SNMA Support for Haiti Campaign, The International Affairs Committee remains steadfast in its support of the Haitian earthquake victims. To this end, we have been working closely with Dr. Mark Wade, president of Arise and Walk Ministries, to provide opportunities for SNMA members to attend week-long mission trips to Haiti.

Dr. Mark Wade is a long-time supporter of SNMA; he is a former Professional Board Member and has participated in several of our annual conferences. There are two upcoming missions trips scheduled from May 3 to May 9, and from May 29 to June 4. The trip dates for July and August 2010 will be announced soon. The cost for each trip is approximately \$1,000, and includes round-trip airfare from New York City, lodging, and transportation.
